This week in...

Squirrels

The children have had a great start to their dinosaur topic! We have been creating dinosaur collages, learning dinosaur names and facts. Year 1's have been learning about the habitats of dinosaurs and in RE have been learning about the creation story. Reception have been describing and naming dinosaurs. We made our own pet dinosaurs and have explored making dinosaur land maps. We learnt about other prehistoric animals that lived in the dinosaur time.



This week in...

Hedgehogs

The Hedgehogs have been so excited about our 'Dinosaur Planet' topic so far. We have learnt dinosaur names and discovered what prehistoric Earth looked like. We then created images to show this. In computing we have been creating music using technology. The children have practiced making sequences at both a slow and fast pace. In literacy the children have started their book reviews of Hattie and Olaf. In science they have explored a variety of habitats and recreated the ideal habitat for a given animal.



What have we been learning?

This week in...

Owls

The Owl class this week have been learning how to calculate the area of triangles and parallelograms. We have been talking about the perpendicular height of these shapes and how to find it. The children have continued to work on their non-chronological reports about polar animals and we have been learning lots of new and interesting facts. In science, they have been experimenting with shadows and in PE they have been learning how to throw in athletics. We have many good hammer throwers!



This week in...

Foxes

The fox class have had a fabulous last few days. As Frozen Kingdoms is our new project this summer; they have been busy writing non-chronological reports about penguins and have also begun to research their own polar region animal to learn and write about. In maths, they have finished off decimals and fractions and have moved onto learning about money. In science, the children are learning about states of matter. They are exploring solids, liquids and gases and have proven to be great scientists when investigating how we can measure gas!
