Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to those parents who came to the Opal Play meeting with Kate Smith this week. It was good to share the initiative with you and for you to see the children playing. We are very lucky to have parents who want to make playtimes meaningful for the children and we really appreciate your support.



Last week, Mr Polak our Director of Education and Mr Harts, Head of Pilton Bluecoats visited Umberleigh Academy. They looked at English books and talked to the children about their experiences in school. They

were very impressed with the work produced by the children and their positive attitudes to learning. Later this term, we will be receiving a visit from Neil Swait as part of our TEAM school review cycle. Mr Swait is an Ofsted Inspector who has worked with TEAM to monitor the work of all schools in the trust for a number of years now. Whilst these reviews are challenging, there is also a critical level of support from TEAM that enables Umberleigh to thrive. I will of course keep you informed of the outcomes of that review.

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"We are only a few minutes late" - Does it matter?

Being late for school reduces learning time and does not prepare your child for their future working lives.

- Arrival 5 minutes late every day = 3 days of learning missed each year
- Arrival 15 minutes late every day = 10 days or 2 weeks of learning each year

MINUTES LATE	IMPACT ON YOUR ATTENDANCE IN A YEAR
5 MINUTES A DAY =	3.4 days 98.4% attendance
10 MINUTES A DAY =	6.9 days 97.6% attendance
15 MINUTES A DAY =	10.3 days 94.6% attendance
20 MINUTES A DAY =	13.8 days 92.9% attendance
30 MINUTES A DAY =	20.7 days 89.2% attendance

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Fire Safety Talk from Devon & Somerset Fire & Rescue Service – On Tuesday, 5th March we welcome the fire service into school to talk to the children about fire safety and prevention.



Year 2, 3 & 4 will have a 45-minute talk and cover the following: -


- recognise the ways the Fire Service can help us
- begin to understand how fire can be prevented
- understand the dangers of smoke and importance of smoke alarms
- know who the other emergency services are and the number to dial in an emergency
- recognise why you should never play with matches and lighters
- identify the feelings that you have if a situation feels unsafe and know who to tell
- know what to do if your clothes catch fire – Stop Drop and Roll

And our Years 5 & 6 will have a 60-minute talk covering the following: -

- understand the role of the fire service in protecting people and keeping them safe
- know when and when not to call the emergency services
- recognise what you can do to reduce **risk** and **prevent** a fire starting
- understand that your actions and behaviour affects others
- understand what to do if a situation makes you feel unsafe


Wednesday, 6th March – Squirrels & Hedgehogs trip to the Queens Theatre to watch 'Charlie Cooks Favourite Book'.
