| <p>All staff:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ensure that the school's Christian vision and its associated values are well known. develop aspiration in all pupils, giving them resilience to cope well when things are difficult and the perseverance to overcome barriers to their own learning - making positive choices. identify, nurture and celebrate the spirit and essence of every individual pupil. <p>Teaching staff:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ensure all pupils have curriculum opportunities to look beyond themselves, ask 'big questions' and think globally about life. develop an understanding of disadvantage, deprivation and the exploitation of the natural world in all pupils. support pupils to be articulate, active advocates of local, national and global change for the better - challenging injustice and inequality fearlessly. | <p>HoS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> to ensure that all stakeholders in the school know what the school's vision is and are clear about the values associated with it (badges for staff and pupils to wear). to introduce a global project that all pupils are able to 'dive deeply' into, understanding as they do the issues of disadvantage, deprivation and the exploitation of the natural world. to work with staff and the school community to introduce a local project (including a strengthened link with the local church) that all pupils are able to 'dive deeply' into. to work with staff and the school community to build a focus on the individual talents, spirit and essence of all pupils – giving each a 'chance to shine'. to work with staff to ensure that in each of the three areas above, all pupils have the opportunity to articulate thoughts and feelings along the way and are invited to consider how their beliefs are effected by their involvement. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conversation with pupils Outcomes of projects and activities Staff discussion Learning walks Lesson observation | |
