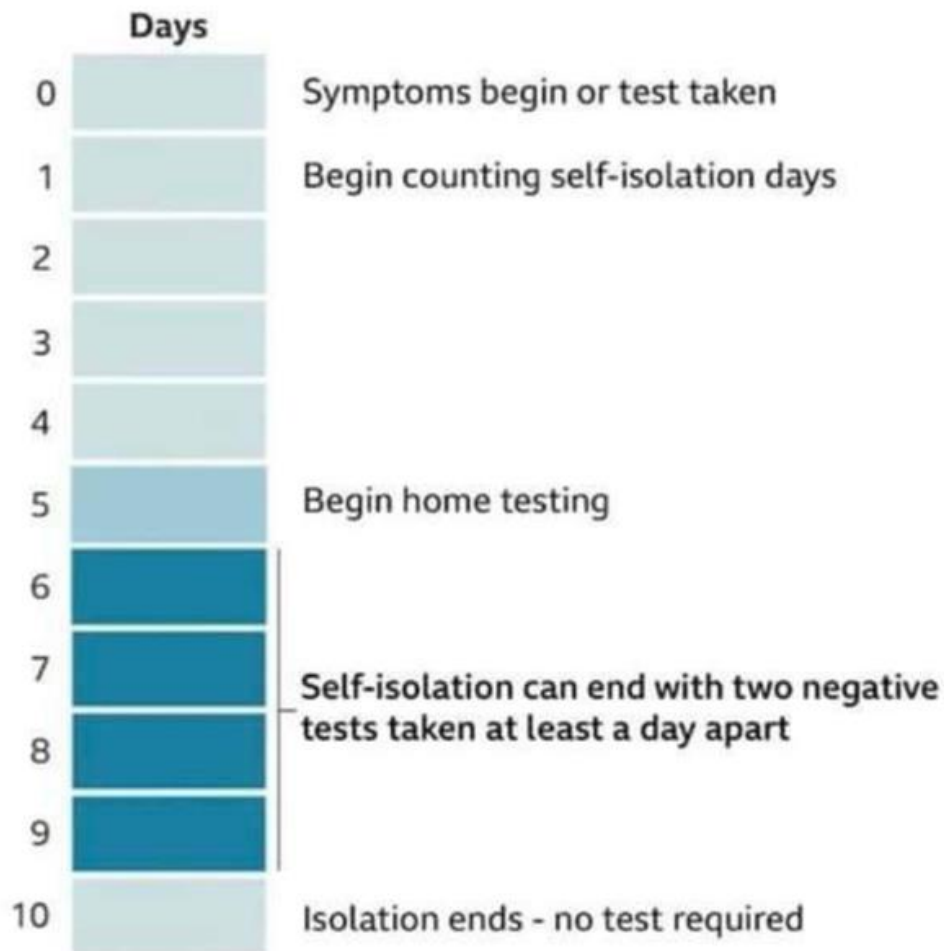

Community Notices

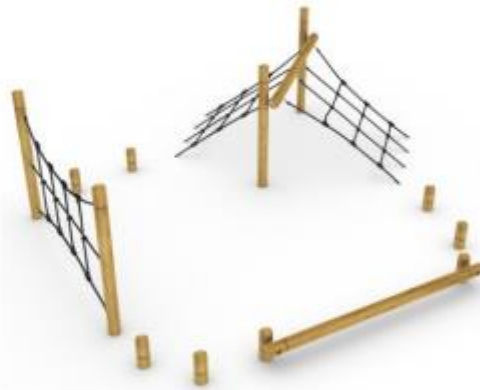
The Atherington Playing Field and Pavilion Committee members have been talking over the last few months about developing the Woodland area of the Playing Field (behind the tennis court).
